**PROPERTY PLANNING COMMITTEE
MINUTES
Wednesday July 28, 2010 – 7:00 pm
Naples Town Hall**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM

Members present were Penn Worcester, Frank Kitchenka, Rick Paraschak, David Garcia, Mark Smith, Corey Chaplin, Ephrem Paraschak, Jennifer Schaeffer, and Charlie Ahern.

Also present was Town Recreation Director Harvey Price.

The minutes of the June 23rd meeting were approved with corrections.

Discussion was held regarding the committee's concern about beach restrictions. Harvey suggested that we not restrict these concerns to the beach, but rather should include all recreation facilities. Charlie requested that the minutes of his motion at the June 23rd meeting be corrected as he only referred to pets at the beach. Charlie also volunteered to provide the committee with a proposed ordinance that we can provide to the Select Board.

Harvey reported that he was contacted by Bob Jensen, Site Supervisor for the Vocational school, who suggested that we might be able to use his students for a beach project such as a covered pavilion. He also felt that if local young people did the work, the potential for vandalism might be reduced through peer pressure. Penn made a motion for Harvey to pursue this offer and check on other potential criteria such as insurance, transportation, and etc. The motion was approved unanimously.

Rick reported that the construction of the changing building was delayed, awaiting approval of the Fire Marshall. He also noted that the schedule might be moved to the fall so that beach usage would not be affected by construction activities.

The fireworks barge is presently back at the beach but will be moved to a new location next week.

The Topo map requested at our May meeting, has been created and was shown to the committee. This is required for creating definitive plans for the proposed Boat Launch facility. Derik was requested to meet with DEP personnel regarding reclaiming the old shoreline as shown on the Topo map and the procedure for proceeding with plans for the Boat Launch facility.

An informal discussion followed concerning the restrictions listed on the signs presently in place at the beach. It was noted that public drinking is illegal per state law.

The next meeting will be held at the Town Hall at 7:00 pm, August 25, 2010.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm
