MOORING FACTSHEET

- Mooring placement shall be the responsibility of the property owner.
- New moorings are \$20 and shall be \$10 to renew annually. Permits must be renewed by July 15th of each year. If a mooring is not renewed by that time, the cost will be \$20.
- According to State Statute, only one mooring is allowed per lot with at least 50' of direct water frontage, unless a mooring field has been assigned to an Association or Campground approved by local Harbor Master.
- No mooring shall be placed outside the area of the water safety zone, specifically 200' from any shore or one third the distance to the opposite shore, whichever is less, or in areas that will create a hazard to navigation to all watercraft.
- Moorings shall be placed as far away from an abutter's property/shoreline as possible, in accordance to the Harbor Master's discretion.
- In the event of failure to comply with these instruction, the Harbor Master shall move or cause to have removed by a commercial operator the improperly located mooring at the expense of the assigned owner. Failure to more or remove a mooring at the order of the Harbor Master is a violation of the Mooring Regulations.
- Moorings must comply to all specification and permits required by the Town and State of Maine.
- All mooring anchors shall be made of stone, granite, or cured reinforced concrete or mushroom anchor.
- Moorings shall be white in color with a blue strip as required by State Law.
