Planning Board Minutes
June 6th, 2016
7:00 pm

Chairman Larry Anton called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, also present were Jim Allen, John Thompson, Barbara Adlard, Doug Bogdan, Alternate Jim Krainin, and Town Secretary Kate Matthews.

Barbara Adlard motioned to approve the minutes from the 5/3/16 meeting. Jim Allen seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved, with Mr. Bogdan abstaining.

New Business:

- 1.) An application for an outdoor entertainment permit submitted by the Town of Naples for Outdoor Movie Nights open to the public to be held at Kent's Landing on July 1st & 15th and August 5th & 26th, 2016.

The town manager was present to explain the Movie Night and answer any questions. He said that the recreation department would have staff present at each movie night to direct the public on where to sit and park, etc. An inflatable movie screen and speakers would be placed adjacent to the restrooms, facing Route 302. Anyone in attendance would be facing Long Lake on the small slope, where they can sit down on blankets or chairs that they bring. Mr. Paraschak also let the board know that they were considering allowing non-profits to sell things like popcorn and water during the movie nights.

The board asked about overflow parking since the event would be open to the public and not just Town Residents. Mr. Paraschak let them know that they would be welcome to use the Town Office and Fire Station besides the on street parking. The board agreed that it was a great idea and that it would hopefully bring more people to the causeway area business during the summer.

As there was no further discussion, Jim Allen made a motion to accept the application. John Thompson seconded the motion. The board was unanimously in favor.
