RE: Dollar General - Route 302, Naples, Seasonal Adjustment of Trip Generation Calculations


Dear Bob;

The purpose of this letter is to follow-up with you about potential seasonal adjustments to trip generation calculations, which were determined using the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) Trip Generation Manual, for the proposed 10,640sf, Dollar General Retail store.

In short, site generated trip calculations are not adjusted based on seasonal fluctuations in traffic. Only the existing background traffic volumes on Route 302 and the area roadway network are seasonally adjusted as part of traffic studies. The ITE Trip Generation Manual estimates the peak hour trips that would be generated by a proposed facility using average peak hours rates that have been determined based on traffic counts that have been collected at similar type uses around the country, and are not to be seasonally adjusted. This is consistent with Maine DOT Traffic Study Methods and Policies that are followed for Traffic Movement Permits.
