

**TOWN OF NAPLES
PLANNING BOARD
MINUTES
Tuesday, June 3, 2014 – 7:00 pm
Municipal Offices Buildings**

Larry Anton called the meeting to order. Also present were John Thomson, Kevin Rogers, Jim Allen, Jeff Juneau, code enforcement officer Renee' Carter and town secretary Kate Matthews.

The first order of business was to approve the minutes from May 6th, 2014. Jim Allen motioned to accept the minutes. Kevin Rogers seconded the motion. The minutes were approved by four, with Jeff Juneau abstaining.

Next on the agenda was an outdoor entertainment permit application submitted by the Naples Historical Society for The Wheels and Water Show located at 97 State Park Road and found on Naples Tax Map U22, Lot 7. It is an annual event, and no complaints had been received by the abutters that were contacted. The music would be over by 7:00 pm. Mr. Thompson was concerned because the application was not complete, and was missing some answers. Jim Allen motioned to approve the application. Kevin Rogers seconded. All were in favor besides Mr. Thompson who opposed.

The last item on the agenda was an outdoor entertainment permit application submitted by Kevin Kimball for the Maine Blues Festival located throughout Naples Village. Present to represent the Blues Festival were Kevin Kimball and Kent Uicker. The music schedule would be as follows: Friday June 13th 6:00 pm – 11:30 pm; Saturday June 14th 12:00 pm -12:00 am; and Sunday June 15th 12:00pm – 11:00 pm. Alcohol would only be served at licensed vendors. Parking will be provided at the Fire Station, the lot next to Moose Landing, the American Legion Hall, and at the High School. There would also be a total of 17 porta-potties this year spread around the entire area. Trash will be taken care of by the Blues Festival on the day of and following the event. Show Dog Security will once again be present, who they used the previous year and were very happy with. Shuttle busses will be in use once again, and this year will be going to campgrounds to create less traffic. John Thompson motioned to approve the application. Jim Allen seconded the motion. The board was in favor with Kevin Rogers abstaining.

John Thompson motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Rogers seconded. Meeting adjourned.
