Per Maine law, mooring balls must be white with a horizontal blue stripe and the current year's assigned mooring permit sticker must be displayed. The sticker must be viewable from a boat, and all old stickers must be removed or covered by the current sticker. A mooring must comply with Town Ordinances. All moorings are subject to yearly review & inspection. Noncompliant moorings are subject to removal at the property owner's expense. **Renewals applications must be received before July 15th each year. A \$35.00 late fee will be applied to all submissions received after this date.** Fees are listed on the Town's Fee Schedule.
