

TOWN MANAGER'S UPDATE

This weeks update focuses on *Municipal Admin, Transfer Station, and Community*

**Municipal Admin:**

- **Select Board Meeting:** The next Select Board meeting will take place **NEXT Monday** November 25th, starting at 6pm. Those unable to attend in person can watch live one Lake Regions Television or watch a recorded version of the meeting the following day on line at [Lake Regions Television](#). - **Planning Board Meeting:** This past Tuesday the planning board met and reviewed a change of use application at 978 Roosevelt Trail as well as a new Cell Tower application at 26 Wilderness Way, Map-Lot R07-045. A recording of the meeting can be viewed at [LRTV Online](#).
- **HOLIDAY CLOSURE:** Town offices will be **closed November 28th and 29th** in observance of Thanksgiving (*state offices will also be closed*). For your convenience many routine Clerk Related services can be complete through the [ONLINE Services Link](#) on the Town Website. If you have business that must be completed in person next week the clerks counter will be *open Nov 26th and 27th during regularly scheduled operating hours (7:30am - 4:30pm)*

**Transfer Station:**

- **Municipal Waste:** As mentioned in last weeks update we are looking to address the new traffic pattern at the municipal waste facility. When the new traffic pattern was originally conceived the primary planning factor was to allow residents to dump their municipal waste before they dumped recycling material. Observations over the past 4 weeks clearly indicate a change in the pattern is needed before Memorial Day. We have consulted with a traffic engineer and the firm is working a revision to the traffic flow pattern. We are exploring temporary traffic pattern options before the lot can be repainted in the spring. Stand by for future updates.
- **Bulky Waste:** The Bulky Waste station will be **closed from 28 Oct - 10 January** for renovations. Recent conversations with the Contractor indicate that he and his team will make every effort to complete the work ahead of schedule. During this time, residents are encourage to hold bulky waste items at their home or if necessary residents can use the PineTree facility located on Songo School Rd. Use of this facility is "Pay as you Go" and coupons will NOT be accepted. When the facility upgrades are complete there will be a new digital scanning system that will replace coupon books. In coming reports I will provide details on how the system will work and how residents can obtain their digital tags.

## **Community:**

- **Causeway Lighting:** Causeway lights have been installed and many residents have already expressed excitement for the coming holiday season. This years lighting effort is a significant change from what we have seen in previous years. While we are confident lighting scheme will be magnificent, every project should seek to improve through iteration. We welcome any and all feedback that allows our Holiday lighting project to improve year after year.
