Winter Season Mooring Ball Removal

To: All Mooring Holders

Due to an increase in reports of damaged, missing and moved/shifted moorings over the winter months on Naples lakes and ponds, for the purposes of prevention of spring and summer mooring failure and to prevent damage or personal injury to snowmobiles and ATV's the Town of Naples has adopted the order to remove or sink to make safe all mooring balls for the winter months.

As pursuant to the Naples Marine Safety Enforcement Ordinance Section 9 Subsection 9.2:

9.2 In accordance with the Town of Naples this Marine Division Ordinance, the Town has established December 1st as the due date to have all mooring balls removed from the waterways. Failure to remove mooring balls past the December 1st due date will result in an ordinance violation and will result in fines issued by the Town. Failure to comply with the removal date or failure to pay fines will result in the loss of mooring privileges.
