MINUTES
Tuesday, March 17, 2015 – 7:00 pm
Municipal Offices Buildings**

Larry Anton called the meeting to order. Also present Jim Allen, Doug Bogdan, Barbara Adlard, Alternate Jim Krainin and Code Enforcement Officer Renee Carter.

Jim Krainin was appointed a voting member for the meeting.

Jim Allen made a motion to approve the minutes from October 21, 2014 and December 16, 2014. Mr. Anton said there was an extra word in the last sentence of the last paragraph in the minutes for October 21, 2014 minutes that needed to be deleted. Mr. Anton seconded the motion with the change. The minutes were approved.

New business:

- A.) An Outdoor Entertainment Permit Application submitted by George Vooris regarding a 5K Race benefiting the Dempsey Center spanning from the Naples Causeway to Route 114.

George Vooris was present to answer any questions the board may have about the race. He had been in contact with Mark Scribner from Naples Fire and Rescue along with Don Klemanski from Cumberland County Sheriff Department. He also contacted DOT regarding traffic control and had plans for having a volunteer group during the event to ensure everything runs smoothly. He spoke to different businesses in town to make sure that no one would have any issues and everyone he talked to thought it would be an asset to the Town. The event will be held on August 30, 2015 which is a Sunday at 8:00 am (rain or shine) so that traffic will be minimal. Mr. Vooris said that there would be between 5-8 porta potties available. He has plans for multiple flaggers to keep the runners in a separate area that will be coned off from traffic. Mr. Bogdan wanted to clarify if the runners would be crossing traffic. George Vooris explained that the runners would keep to one side of the road only. The fee other than advertising was waved by the Selectboard. Barbara Adlard made a motion to approve the application for the 5k race. Jim Allen seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously in favor.

As there was no other business, meeting was adjourned.
